



### **Minister's Conference July 9-12, 2010 Rolduc Center, Netherlands**

A first-time gathering of Unitarian, Unitarian Universalist, and liberal ministers from around the world, to meet one another, share the similarities and differences of our callings, make collegial connections, and open new avenues for communication and collaboration in ministry.

This three and a half day conference will include presentations, small group meetings, workshops, worship and plenty of time for getting to know one another.

Presentations will focus on the general themes of:

- The Call to Ministry
- Liberal Ministry in a Global Context and a Global Movement
- How Oppression and Freedom Shape our Ministry

The minister's conference will be followed immediately by the third ICUU International U-U Theological Symposium, open to non-ministers as well. (See other side). Both conferences will take place in the Netherlands, at the Rolduc Conference Center, a former abbey transformed into a hotel and conference center. Rolduc is located in Kerkrade, NL, at the heart of the Muese-Rhine Euregion, which straddles the Netherlands, Germany and Belgium. Eindhoven, Maastricht, Aachen, Cologne, and Liege are all within easy traveling distance. We will be welcomed by our partners in the Dutch Remonstrant church, and learn more about them during our time in the Netherlands.

Cost: 285 Euros for accommodation in double room with sink or shower, shared toilets, plus 3 meals per day, one coffee break, and program costs. For en-suite accommodation in a double room, there is an extra charge of 35 Euros. For single room with sink or shower, shared toilets, there is an extra charge of 55 Euros. For single room en-suite accommodation, there is an extra charge of 130 Euros.

The conference fee is discounted for those registering for both conferences. The registration deadline is February 28, 2010. (Cancellations between 3 months and 1 week before the conference will be required to pay a percentage of the reservation cost.) Some subsidies may be available for registrants from ICUU member groups and emerging groups in non-western economies.
